#### **IV. NEW BUSINESS:**

A. COUNTY ENGINEER: KDOT No Passing Zones Study and Signing Project:

-Barry McManaman, County Engineer, will provide details. Barton County has been selected to receive Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) funding to analyze the need for no passing zones and signing on 77 miles of roads. These County blacktops, primarily in the southern half of Barton County, have not previously been studied for no passing zones. KDOT is asking the County Commission to approve the project. KDOT will cover the total design and construction cost, estimated at \$171,000.00.

Barry McManaman, County Engineer, said in the past they had a consulting firm do the studies on a ple of projects on major collector routes. With the approval of this project, they would go back and the project of the major collector routes that had not had studies done, as well as some of the minor collector

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I local road blacktops. One of the requirements by KDOT when requesting funding was to have an engineering study done.

Commissioner Zimmerman asked if that was the area Road & Bridge was already working on. McManaman said it was the same area.

Commissioner Schlessiger moved to approve the Kansas Department of Transportation, Bureau of Local Projects, Project Programming Request for the No Passing Zone Evaluation and Signing. Commissioner Zimmerman seconded the motion.

All voted aye. Motion passed.

## B. RESOLUTION 2023-18: A Resolution Transferring Monies from the General Fund to the Barton County Employee Trust Fund:

-Matt Patzner, County Administrator, will provide details. The County has traditionally provided certain funding to source employee engagement. As the Employee Relations Committee has been dissolved, it is suggested that the Commission transfer \$10,000.00 to be used for employee engagement. In addition, that Brenda Kaiser, Human Resource Director, be tasked with development of an Employee Engagement Committee.

Matt Patzner, County Administrator, said typical practices had included a summer picnic, holiday party, beef bundles, jackets and retirement gifts. The Employee Relations Committee that had been responsible for these had been dissolved. It was suggested that the Commission transfer \$10,000.00 to be used for employee engagement. Some of the areas to be focused on were employee morale, community service and employee input on benefits and certain policies. Looking at putting together a five-person board of interested employees. Patzner felt it was important to have employee engagement with input from the ployees.

Commissioner Hutchinson felt this was a good idea.

Commissioner Esfeld said instead of having a representative from each department having to participate, this group would be just a few interested employees who want to participate.

Patzner said ideas would be generated from the employees and would go before the commission for action to be taken.

Commissioner Schlessiger said it was exciting to get five employees who can spread their enthusiasm.

Commissioner Reif moved to adopt Resolution 2023-18, A Resolution Transferring Monies from the General Fund to the Barton County Employee Trust Fund. Further, direct Ms. Kaiser to begin developing an Employee Engagement Committee.

Commissioner Esfeld seconded the motion.

All voted aye. Motion passed.
