JUVENILE SERVICES: Fiscal Year 2018 Reinvestment Grant:

-Juvenile Services has collaborated with Healing Hearts Ranch to apply for grant funding to provide equine-assisted psychotherapy/learning for youth and families in the Twentieth Judicial District. Per directives from the Kansas Department of Corrections, Juvenile Services can request no more than \$128,313.00. If approved, the funding will provide 48 clinical hours of therapy each week, with the goal of serving 253 youth. As the Administrative County for Juvenile Services, the Commission will be asked to approve the grant request.

Marissa Woodmansee, Juvenile Services Director, said the DOC instructed all grant applicants to stay within an allocated \$128,313 and noted the funds will provide therapy, specifically 48 clinical hours of service per week. Their goal is to serve 253 individuals. Woodmansee said KDOC is providing the opportunity to write for funds saved by youth not going to out of home placements. This service is intended to strengthen the services in the community. Woodmansee said they will know if they are to receive funding by the later part of December 2017.

Kelly Johnson, Healing Hearts Ranch, said they have been around since 2007 and noted they follow the model from Eagala (an International program with evidence based support).

Commissioner Davis moved to approve the Fiscal Year Reinvestment Grant request of \$128,313.00 to the Kansas Department of Corrections. Authorize the Commission Chair to sign all required documents. Commissioner Straub seconded the motion.
