

RESOLUTION 1999-09

**STOP SIGN AT SE 20 AVENUE AND SE 40 ROAD, SOUTH BEND TOWNSHIP
BARTON COUNTY, KANSAS**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, is a legally elected, qualified and acting body and has jurisdiction of the following described roads; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the public health and welfare, and on the basis of an engineering and a traffic investigation, which bears on the fact that a stop sign on the following described roads is needed for reasonable or safe conditions, it is deemed in the public interest that the stop sign on the roadways be placed as herein set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2008, that a stop sign be placed on the following described roadways as described:

To be placed at the intersection of SE 20 AVENUE and SE 40 ROAD
– Stop signs shall be installed on the north and south sides of the intersection so that traffic arriving from the north and south must stop and yield the right of way to the east and west traffic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all sign installation shall be made and maintained by Barton County and in accordance with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" as sanctioned by the Kansas Department of Transportation; and






