

RESOLUTION 2004-28

PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, has jurisdiction to place and maintain traffic control devices upon roadways under their jurisdiction as they may deem necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the public interest to control and regulate traffic at the intersection of various Barton County roads within this jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, that the following signage should be placed at the following intersections:


That at the intersection of NE 40 Avenue and NE 40 Road, all being located in Barton County, Kansas, further described as the intersection of Sections 1 and 12, Township 19 South, Range 13 West and Sections 6 and 7, Township 19 South, Range 12 West, stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of said County roads on the east and west sides, so traffic arriving from the east and west must stop for north and south bound traffic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all sign installation shall be made and maintained by the Board of Barton County Commissioners in accordance with the "Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices" as set forth by the Federal Highway Administration and adopted by the Kansas Department of Transportation.

ALSO RESOLVED that should this Resolution be in conflict with any other resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, that only the conflicting part of the previous resolution, and not the previous resolution in total, shall be declared void and ineffective.



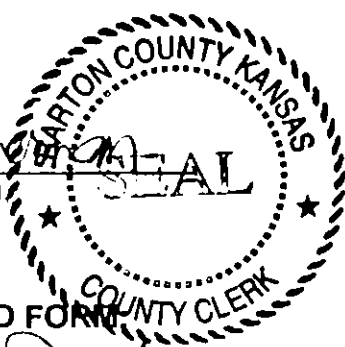
