I. OPENING BUSINESS:

C. SHERIFF'S OFFICE: County Impound Auction:

-The Barton County Sheriff's Office will have an impound auction at 6:00 p.m., Friday, September 19, 2008, at the Road and Bridge Shop, 1204 – 7th, Great Bend.

Sheriff Causey provided details and noted there are 24 vehicles to be sold at the County Impound Auction, unless claimed prior to sale. He said other county departments have been invited to put items in the sale.

D. CENTRAL KANSAS COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS: Sale of Vehicle:

-Central Kansas Community Corrections (CKCC) owns a vehicle that is used by the supervision officer in monitoring offenders. That vehicle, a 2001 Ford Crown Victoria, has 115,000 miles and is becoming unreliable. As such, it is suggested that it be included in the Sheriff's Office impound auction. Proceeds would be used to offset the cost of a replacement vehicle.

Amy Boxberger, CKCC Director, provided details.

Commissioner Krier moved to sell the 2001 Ford Crown Victoria at the County Impound Auction with all proceeds going to the county.

Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion.

E. VEHICLE PURCHASE: Sheriff's Office \ Community Corrections:

-Guy Disney, Special Enforcement Officer, works jointly for the Sheriff's Office and Central Kansas Community Corrections. As such, Disney is responsible for the day-to-day enforcement of terms and conditions of intensive probation of offenders within the 20th Judicial District. Given the age and condition of the vehicle currently used by Disney, it is suggested a replacement be purchased.

Sheriff Buck Causey provided details.

The 2005 Ford Crown Victoria has 49,500 miles on it.

Commissioner Krier asked if CKCC could allocate money from next year's budget to pay back the County's cost of the vehicle. Richard Boeckman, County Counselor/Administrator said no.
